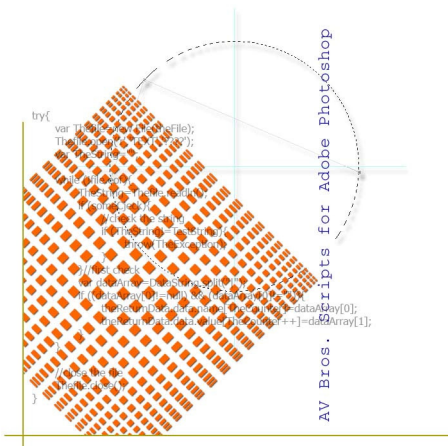

AV Bros. Circumscriber 1.1 is targeted to help you quickly and easily circumscribe a circle (as the selection) around either two (2) or three (3), specified by you, points.

We have developed a useful and convenient utility, which is a good timesaver.

** **The Script** is the computer language, which is used for manipulating the parameters and functions of the host. (In our case, the host is Adobe Photoshop CS.)*

Introduction

We recommend that you read this User Guide. Although the product is very easy to use, the understanding of its details will help you to obtain results faster.

Installing

AV Bros. Circumscriber 1.1 is Adobe Photoshop JavaScript utility. Below you will find instructions on how to install this utility in Adobe Photoshop CS.

How to install AV Bros. Circumscriber 1.1 into Photoshop CS (Windows or Mac OS X):

- Close Photoshop CS.
- Unzip the **AVCircumscriber1.1.zip** file. (In the archive you will find **AV Bros. Circumscriber 1.1.js** file.)
- Put **AV Bros. Circumscriber 1.1.js** into the Photoshop Scripts' folder (**Photoshop CS/Presets/Scripts**).
- Start Photoshop. You'll find the just installed script under the **File>Scripts>AV Bros. Circumscriber 1.1**.

Overview

AV Bros. Circumscriber 1.1 lets you circumscribe a circle (as the selection) around either two (2) or three (3) points, which are anchor points of the work path.

AV Bros. Circumscriber 1.1 provides several possibilities that make the utility useful and a good timesaver. Please review the complete List of Features of AV Bros. Circumscriber 1.1.

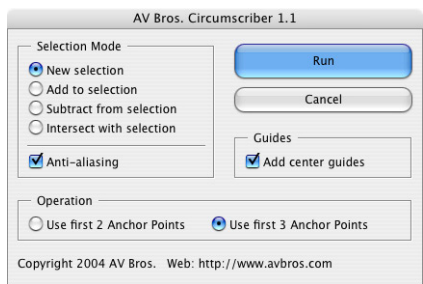
List of Features

- The ability to circumscribe a circle (as the selection) around either two (2) or three (3) points, which are anchor points of the work path.
 - The ability to choose one of the following methods on how the created circular selection interacts with the existing (in the active document) selection:
 - New Selection (If there is no selection in the active document.)
 - Add to the selection
 - Subtract from the selection
 - Intersect with the selection
 - The ability to turn ON/OFF the Anti-aliasing option for the created circular selection.
 - The ability to set the center guides for the created circular selection.

The Work Area and Controls

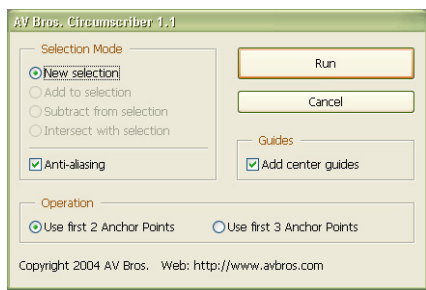
The work area of AV Bros. Circumscriber 1.1 consists of three areas (Selection Mode, Operation and Guides) with controls and two separate buttons (Run and Cancel). All controls are located on the single window.

Selection Mode

This area contains controls (radio-buttons) for choosing the desired type of the interaction between creating circular selection and the existing selection and check box for turning ON/OFF the Anti-aliasing option.

You can choose one of the following types of interaction:

- New Selection (If there is no selection in the active document.)
- Add to the selection
- Subtract from the selection
- Intersect with the selection

To choose the desired type, just choose the appropriate radio-button. As for the Anti-aliasing option - to turn this option ON, just select the Anti-aliasing check box. (Or deselect it if you want to turn this option OFF.)

Operation

This area contains two controls (both are radio-buttons) – *Use First 2 Anchor Points* and *Use First 3 Anchor Points*. Depending on what radio-button you decide to choose, the circular selection will pass through the first two (2) or the first three (3) anchor points of the work path.

Guides

This area contains only one control – *Add Center Guides* check box. Select this check box if you want the center guides to be set along with the created circular selection.

Run, Cancel

Click the Run button if you are happy with the settings and want AV Bros. Circumscriber 1.1 to do its job – to circumscribe a circle (as the selection). The utility's window will be closed.

Click the Cancel button if you want to quit AV Bros. Circumscriber 1.1. The utility's window will be closed.

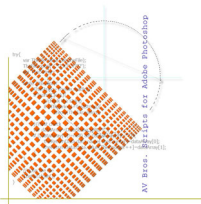

How It Works

AV Bros. Circumscriber 1.1 creates a circular selection, which will pass through either two (2) or three (3) anchor points of the work path of the active document. If you create the circular selection that passes through only two anchor points, then the line that connects these points is the diameter of the creating circular selection.

To start the process, you should either choose the pen tool of Photoshop CS and set the appropriate number of anchor points in the desired places or use the anchor points of the work path that you have prepared before. (If the work path has more anchor points than specified by the chosen radio-button in Operation area, then the utility will ignore those extra anchor points.) Once you are happy with the location of the anchor points, you should call AV Bros. Circumscriber 1.1 and make the desired settings using the utility's controls described above. Then run the script.

Note! We recommend that you make a shortcut to AV Bros. Circumscriber 1.1, using one of the methods provided by Photoshop CS, in order to make the process of creating the desired circular selection even faster and more convenient.
