Introduction

This sample shows how a PDF document can interact with publically available web services. The communication protocol used is the simple object adaptor protocol (SOAP), accessed through the SOAP JavaScript object provided by the application.

The service demonstrated in this sample is the infamous Eliza computer psychoanalyst. The service supports a single method that takes a parameter of type `xsd:string` and returns an `xsd:string`. Information on the SOAP envelope is displayed on the JavaScript console.
