

Small E-mail Sender 2.0

Description

This small application allows you to do just one simple task – send an e-mail. To accomplish this, there is no need to look for or setup any existing e-mail client. All you need to do is just provide your account data, compose an e-mail message and that's it.

Installation

There is no need to install the application, as it is standalone – no installation process or administrator rights are required.

Requirements

.NET Framework Version 2.0 Redistributable, available at microsoft.com:

Security

Account-related information is stored only while the application is loaded into the memory. There is no need to remove any data from the computer – send an e-mail, close the application and that's it – no personal information remains on the disk.

Integration (Import contact list from Outlook)

You can now easily add contact list to Small E-mail Sender from Outlook.

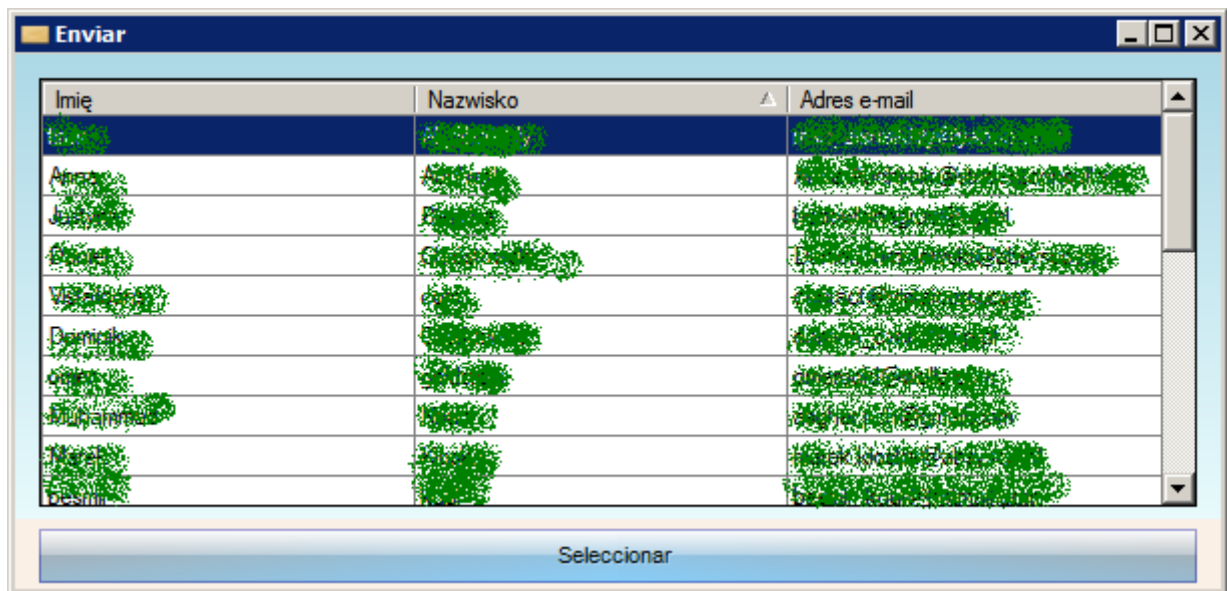
All you need to do is navigate to: File > Import Export > Export to file, and select to export Address Book to “comma delimited file”.

Other e-mail clients

If you have other e-mail client than Outlook, it's high likely you can do the same. Please refer to your client's help in this point.

Now, when you have the file with address book created, rename it to: “Contacts.CSV” and place in the same folder as the application

Now open Small E-mail Sender and choose “Select” button next to “To” field of main window. What you'll see is your contact list like the one below:

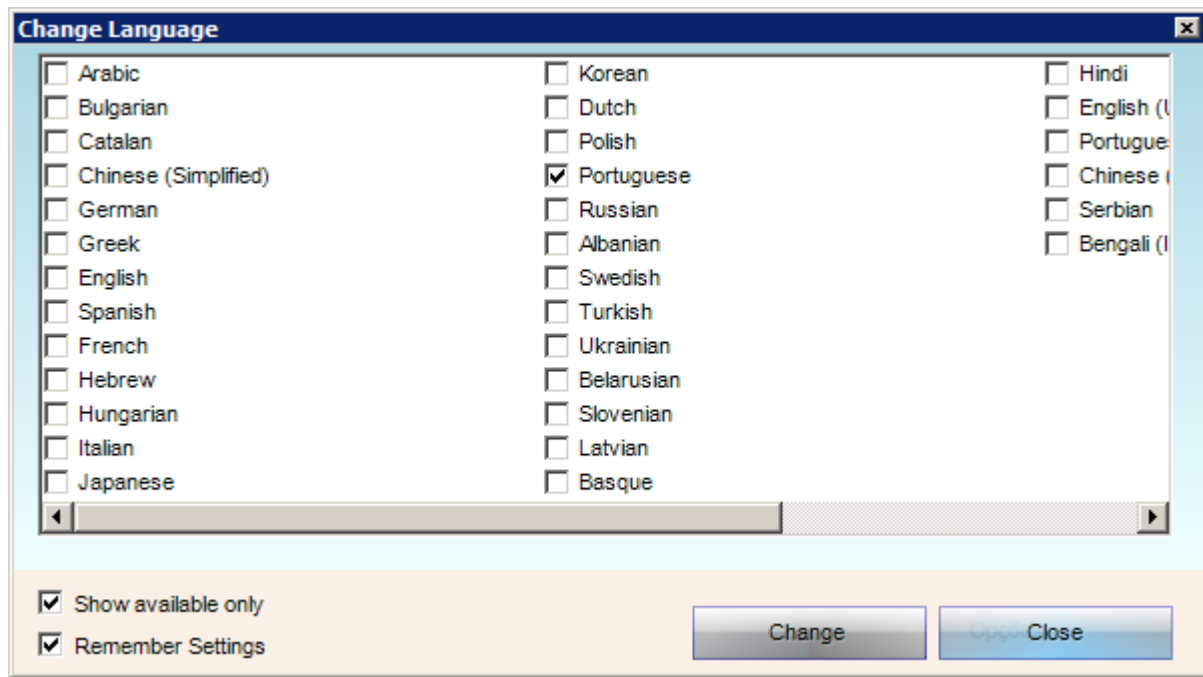


After choosing the right person for your e-mail push the “Select” button, and the e-mail will be placed in the “To” field of main window.

Language support

During the first run, the application attempts to select your system's current language. If it is not supported, the language is set to English by default.

You can change your application language by navigating to: Options > Change Language:



If you choose “Remember Settings,” your language preferences will be stored in the system registry and the application will retrieve them during the next run.

If you uncheck “Show available only,” a list of all supported languages will become available.

Now Small E-mail Sender supports 32 languages:

Arabic, Bulgarian, Catalan, Chinese Traditional, Chinese Simplified, German, Greek, English, Spanish, French, Hebrew, Hungarian, Italian, Japanese, Korean, Dutch, Polish, Portuguese, Russian, Albanian, Swedish, Turkish, Ukrainian, Belarusian, Slovenian, Latvian, Basque, Hindi, English, Portuguese Brazil, Serbian and Bengali.

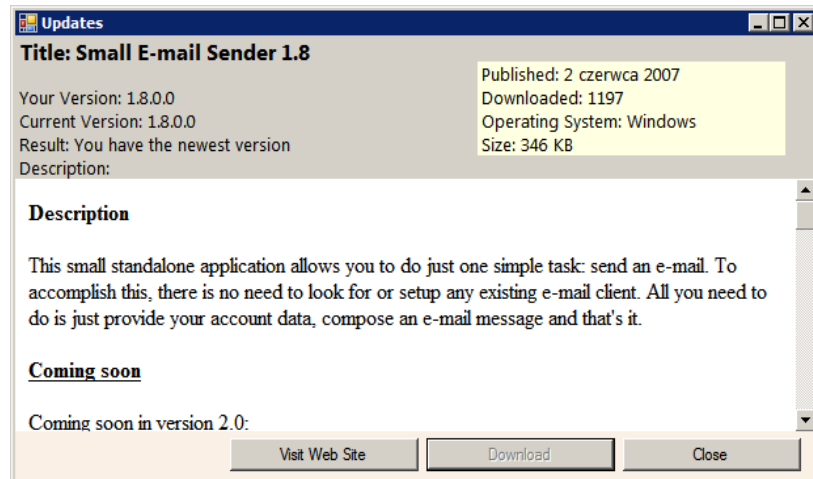

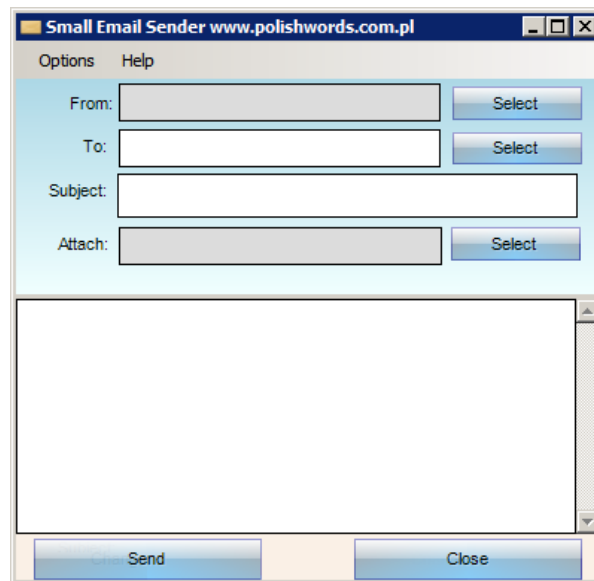
Auto Update

You can easily update your application with just one click – navigate to Help > Update:



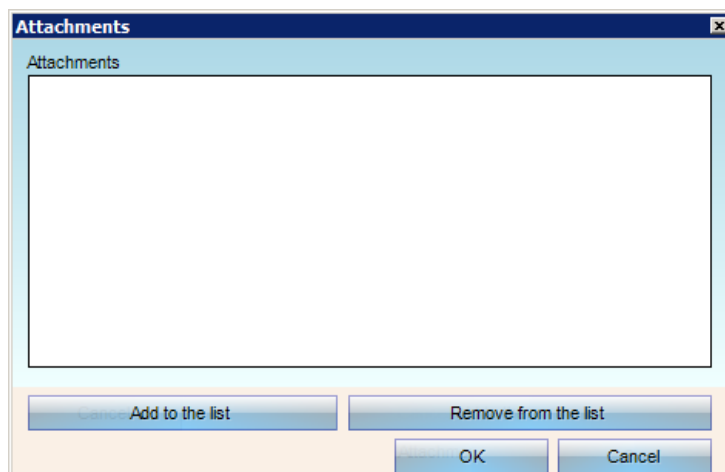
If a new version is available, all you have to do to update your application is press the “Download” button!

Manual



This is the application's main window. You can type the subject, the address of the recipient and the message body here.

After you press the Select button next to the “Attach” field, multiple attachments can be added to your message:



When you are ready to send the e-mail, you need to make sure (once the application is running) that account-related data has been provided. You can provide this data by pressing the Select button next to the “From” field:

The “From” and “SMTP” fields must be filled according to your e-mail account settings. You can choose to connect via SSL (if your e-mail account provider supports SSL connections). If needed, set the SMTP Authorization according to the e-mail account settings.

The account configuration information is stored only when the application is running, so you only need to set this once before sending your e-mails. Once you close the application, the account settings will be removed from your computer.
