

TwitterMySearch

Introduction


TwitterMySearch displays twitter search results beside your Google searches. These come directly from search.twitter.com and are based upon the entry you make in Google. So if you enter “Shoreditch minicabs” in this is sent to search.twitter.com as Shoreditch+minicabs. If there are no recent messages for that search TwitterMySearch will let you know and suggest you try another search.

Installation

Download the installation zip, unpack into a folder, double-click the setup.exe, follow the instructions.

Operation

The installation program will place an icon on your desktop. Double click and the program will place a small icon in your system tray.



By default the program adds itself to your startup so you can enable and disable the program with ease. If you would rather not have it start automatically then uncheck “Automatically start with windows”.

When you search in Google the program will automatically search for matching tweets in twitter and display the results on the right hand side.


Troubleshooting

I selected “Enable TwitterMySearch” but nothing changes in Google, what’s up?

Sometimes Browsers block access to their configuration or it sometimes doesn’t work because too much memory is in use or too many tabs open. Close all open browsers and try again.

I am using Opera and it’s not working

Opera allows us to add the configuration but not enable it automatically yet. All you need to do is open File → Settings → Preferences → Advanced Tab → Network → Proxy Servers... and then enable http (the rest of the details will have been completed correctly by TwitterMySearch).



Finally click OK and save changes.

Sometimes the formatting seems garbled on a random page, whether in Google or not, and this only happened after installing TwitterMySearch, how do I fix that?

It is possible that initial use of TwitterMySearch will corrupt some files your browser has placed in its cache. To solve this press Ctrl-F5 and your browser will download the page and display correctly again.

How do I uninstall TwitterMySearch?

With TwitterMySearch running right click the tray icon and select “Disable TwitterMySearch”, right click again and select “Close TwitterMySearch”. Go to Add/Remove Programs in your control Panel and then Uninstall TwitterMySearch.
